JUNIOR LEAGUE OF CHARLOTTESVILLE TO AWARD UP TO \$10,000 IN GRANTS

Grant application period runs February 1 through March 15, 2024

Charlottesville, VA — The Junior League of Charlottesville's annual Community Grants application is open and will run through March 15, 2024. Individual grants of up to \$4,000 will be awarded to fund time-limited projects aligned with the theme of Empowering Women Through Mentorship, the Junior League of Charlottesville's focus area. Applications are due no later than 8 p.m. on March 15, 2024.

Projects must impact women and girls in the Central Virginia area, and ideally recipient organizations would also provide volunteer or training opportunities for League members. Previous grant recipients include Brave Souls on Fire, Piedmont YMCA, Stone Robinson Elementary School, and WTJU Radio.

Applicants must be a 501(c)(3) organization or school, and all past applicant and recipient organizations are welcome to submit an application.
